COURSE SYLLABUS / 2015-2016

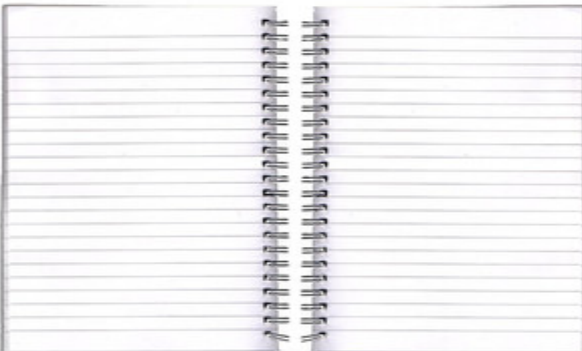
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## WELCOME!

Writer's Craft is a reading and writing intensive course that celebrates the process and craft of creative writing—from the initial spark to the finished product.

### START HERE:

1.



You will need a *writer's notebook*. We will use it every day—to write, list, plan, brainstorm, draw, map, ponder, practice, model, plot, compose, revise, and *make wild, impossible plans*. It is YOUR property. I don't want to read it—unless you feel like sharing—or collect it. It just needs to be with you at all times. It's where all your work will start.

2. THEN WHAT HAPPENS? (GOOD QUESTION.)
